BEd Web Registration Guide – 2009 Winter Session 2 Year Elementary Option – Year 2

Winter Session Information

The Bachelor of Education Elementary Option prepares all teacher candidates to teach all grades (K-7) in the elementary school. The program of studies for the second year includes the Extended Practicum in Term 1, and the specialized courses for the teaching concentration in Term 2.

Teacher candidates must be registered in EDUC 418C prior to reporting to schools to start the practicum.

Start date for the practicum is September 8, 2009, the opening of public schools. Teacher candidates should contact their School Advisors and Faculty Advisors during the last week of August.

Term 2 classes begin on campus January 4, 2010. Significant calendar dates for the entire year have been outlined on the Teacher Education Website <http://teach.educ.ubc.ca>

GENERAL REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Registration opens: June 8, 2009 at 9:00 am**
2. Registrants must pay a \$100 non-refundable deposit **prior to** starting course registration. The deposit can be paid on-line at the Student Service Centre using a MasterCard, VISA or Electronic Funds Transfer. For other payment options, go to <http://students.ubc.ca/finance/fees.cfm>
3. **Plan a conflict-free timetable by creating work lists.** Logon to the Student Services Centre at www.students.ubc.ca/ssc using your Campus Wide Login (CWL). Registrants can create multiple work lists by adding standard timetables (if required) and course sections (see next page). Once registration opens, register into a selected work list. Registration will only be successful if the timetable and/or course has space available.
4. **Ready to begin registration.** Log on to the **Student Services Centre** at www.students.ubc.ca/ssc using your Campus Wide Login (CWL) (new students will be prompted to create a CWL using their student number and birth date).
5. **Register into a selected work list.** If registration into your work list is unsuccessful or if you did not complete a work list prior to the registration date, you will need to proceed with the following steps:
 - **First add a standard timetable:** click Course Schedule, select the session (2009 winter) and click on Standard Timetable (STT). Select your program (BEDE, Year 2), click on your timetable selection and the Register STT button.
 - **To add courses:** click Course Schedule - Add/Drop Courses. Enter the course information and click on Register.
 - **Note: *Course details and registration instructions have been provided on Page 2.***
6. Once registration is complete, click on **Timetable** to view and print your course schedule. Please repeat this process prior to class start as timetable changes may occur.
7. Click on **My Financial Account** to check deadlines and pay fees.

8. Update your mailing and Email addresses.

1. Select and register into the standard timetable entitled: **2 YEAR ELEMENTARY OPTION - YEAR 2**
2. Register in one section of EDST:
 - EDST 429 section 221 OR
 - EDST 454 section 221
3. Register in one section of EPSE 423:
 - EPSE 423 section 223 OR
 - EPSE 423 section 224
4. Register into the E-portfolio section reserved for your subject area concentration:
 - EDUC 480A.221 – Early Childhood Education Specialization
 - EDUC 480A.222 – Math/Science Specialization
 - EDUC 480A.223 – Special Education Specialization
5. Once the above steps have been completed, register into *each* course of your teaching concentration as listed below. **The system will not automatically register you into your concentration courses.**
